



Masters Games 2014 - Tennis Competition

~ Prospectus ~

1. Purpose

: To provide an opportunity to people aged 35 or above to participate in tennis competition and compete against people of similar age, so to enjoy the fun brought by sports and sustain their interest in sports activities.

2. Date & Time

: 7 June – 31 August 2014 (Tue, Thu, Sat & Sun)

7:30 pm – 11:00 pm (Tue & Thu)

2:00 pm - 11:00 pm (Sat) 8:00 am - 11:00 pm (Sun)

3. Venue

: Lai Chi Kok Park (Stage II) Tennis Court

(Address: Lai Wan Road, Lai Chi Kok, Kowloon)

4. Eligibility

: People aged 35 or above are welcome to participate in the Games. Participant's age is calculated against the first day on which the event commences (i.e. those who were born on or before 7 June 1979 are eligible to participate in the competition).

Notes to Applicants

: (1) Participants should be aware of their health condition, and consider whether it is suitable for them to enrol in this Games. In case of doubt, please consult a doctor prior to the enrolment of activity.

- (2) Each applicant may enrol in a <u>maximum of one singles event and one</u> <u>doubles event</u> and pay the enrolment fee once. To facilitate the ballot arrangement, the applicant should submit separate enrolment forms for singles and doubles events with declarations.
- (3) Each applicant should submit only one enrolment form for singles and doubles event. In case of multiple submissions or has submitted an incomplete enrolment form, all enrolment forms submitted by the applicant will not be entertained.
- (4) For better resource utilisation, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) reserves the right to adjust the quota for each division with reference to the enrolment response. The applicants/participants should have no objection.
- (5) For participants entering the doubles event, the division they enter shall be the one to which their youngest team member belongs.
- (6) If there are less than two participants/teams for a particular division, the LCSD reserves the right to combine it with a division of younger age or cancel all events in that division.
- 6. Entry Fee
- : \$20 per person (those aged 60 or above, full-time students and persons with disabilities can enjoy a 50% off concessionary rate upon production of valid identity document(s) during payment). Each applicant should pay the fee according to his/her age on the first day (7 June 2014) of the competition.
- 7. Format
- : (1) A single knock-out system will be adopted in all events.
 - (2) In the preliminary rounds, a set of 6 games will be played. When the game reaches 5-all, the set will be won by the player who first reaches 7 games. When the game reaches 6-all, the final game will be decided by tie-break.
 - (3) In the final, semi-finals and the playoff match for third and fourth places, a set of 8 games will be played. When the game reaches 8-all, the final game will also be decided by tie-break. When the game reaches 40-all, the player who scores first will win.
- 8. Regulations
- : (1) If only one participant/team shows up on the competition day, the player/team will still be given the respective award.
 - (2) Unless otherwise specified in the prospectus, the competition will adopt all rules and regulations approved by the Hong Kong Tennis Association.
- 9. Marshall
- : (1) Participants should pay attention to the announcements of the Organiser and report to the Organiser and take part in the competitions on time. Otherwise, they will be deemed to have forfeited the right to compete.
 - Participants shall arrive at the competition venue at the scheduled time and report to the LCSD staff in person with their original copy of identity documents used for enrolment (Hong Kong residents should produce their Hong Kong Identity Cards. Persons without Hong Kong Identity Cards should produce their valid travel documents such as Passports, Exit-Entry Permits for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao). If the participants fails to produce the above identification document, the LCSD staff reserve the right to disqualify them from the competition. Those who fail to report after 5 minutes of the scheduled time (both players of doubles event shall report at the same time), will be regarded as having withdrawn from the match.
 - (3) Participants shall stay at the venue to prepare for the match after reporting. Those who fail to show up 5 minutes after the judges' roll call or dispatches not enough players in a doubles event will be deemed to have abandoned their participation right.

(4) Participants withdraw or fail to complete all matches will be disqualified. Their results and awards attained will be cancelled and the entry fee will not be refunded.

10. Fixture Draw

The draw will be held at **7:30 pm on 23 May (Fri)** at the Audio-Visual Room, 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin. Members of the public are welcome to attend. Applicants will be notified of the competition schedule, notes to participants and location map of the competition venue in writing by post/fax/e-mail. (If participants do not receive the information before the competition, please contact the LCSD as soon as possible or they may downloaded the information from the LCSD 'Masters Games' webpage.)

11. Umpires

- : (1) Players on bye will take turns to serve as umpires on the same day in the preliminary rounds and they shall carry out the duties arranged by the LCSD. If no umpires can be arranged for the matches, the competitors shall be scored by themselves.
 - (2) From the Round of 16 onwards, umpires will be arranged by the LCSD.
- 12. Appeal : No appeal will be accepted. The decision of the umpire on the spot will be final.

13. Points to Note

- : (1) Participants shall dress themselves in approved tennis attires and wear a pair of non-marking rubber-soled sports shoes during the competition.
 - (2) Participants should bring their own rackets while the tennis balls are provided by the Organiser.
 - (3) Owing to the tight schedule, no warm-up session will be arranged by the Organiser.
 - (4) Participants shall pay attention to the announcement made / notice displayed by the LCSD on the spot and observe all the regulations of the venue.
 - (5) If any participant(s) is/are found to be impostors or having violated the rules or engaged in improper conduct that affects the competition results, the LCSD reserves the right to disqualify the participant(s) from the competition.

14. Awards

: A medal will be awarded to the champion, first, second and third runners-up of each division.

c) Submission of enrolment forms via the Internet.

- (2) If any division is over-subscribed, applicants will be selected by ballot. The ballot will be held **at 10:00 am** on **24 April** (**Thu**) at Room 201, 2/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin. Members of the public are welcome to attend.
- (3) The balloting result will be announced at the DLSOs, any recreational and sports venues with Leisure Link services and on the LCSD 'Masters Games' webpage on **29 April**. Both the successful and waiting list applicants will be notified in writing after the ballot (no priority number will be assigned to applicants on the waiting list). Please note that unsuccessful applicants will not be informed separately. LCSD should not be responsible for the postage delay due to the incorrect or incomplete correspondence address provided by the applicant.
- (4) Successful applicants shall bring along their notification letter, identification document (originals or copies) and entry fee to the DLSOs (during office hours) or any recreational and sports venues with Leisure Link services for verification of their personal particulars and payment of entry fee during the specified payment period. Successful applicants who do not complete the payment procedure within the payment period will be deemed to have abandoned their participation right. Unfilled places, if any, will be filled by waiting list applicants on a first-come-first-served basis during the specified payment period.

- (5) If there are remaining places after the deadline for payment by waiting list applicants, or if the competition is under-subscribed, the LCSD will arrange open enrolment on a first-come-first-served basis from 20 May (starting from 8:30 am) to 21 May at all DLSOs.
- (6) For participants in doubles events, both players in a team shall pay the entry fee, or else the team will be deemed to have abandoned their participation right.
